Human Rights Awareness Workshops

The Human Rights Commission of the Maldives has conducted two human rights awareness workshops in AA and ADH atoll during the month of July and August. The workshops were aimed for the senior officials of both the atolls. Sessions on Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), some of the human rights conventions, Islam and human rights and the roles and functions of HRCM were delivered in these workshops. The workshops were facilitated by commission members and staff.

HRCM has conducted awareness workshops in 12 atolls in the country under this program.



HRCM Releases Report on the Employment Situation in the Maldives



The Human Rights Commission of the Maldives has released its report on the employment situation in the country titled 'The Rapid Assessment of the Employment Situation in the Maldives'. At a function held to publicize the report the President of HRCM Mr. Ahmed Saleem stated that at the end of 2008, the most number of complaints filed at the Commission were regarding issues related to employment, which comprises 23.69% of total number of complaints. He also highlighted on the recommendations put forward in the previous two report released by HRCM, on the housing situation in the Maldives and the increase in the crime rate in the Maldives, is yet to be implemented by the government.

The Report was produced by HRCM in consultation with Dr. Mohamed Munnavaru, a former Attorney General.

Did You Know?

According to the population census 2006, the total number of Maldivians employed was 110,231.

The main industry in the country, tourism employed 10,578 Maldivians and is Male dominated with only 3.7% females.

Out of the 70,000 people employed in construction and related industries 60% are migrant workers.

HRCM Attends 14th Annual Meeting of APF



A delegation from HRCM represented the National Human Rights Institution of the Maldives at the 14th Annual meeting of APF held in Jordan from 4-6 August 2009.

Speaking at the meeting, President of HRCM Mr. Ahmed Saleem said that the HRCM intends to use human rights as a uniting force to cut across all differences, and to promote a shared


vision of a future where human rights are better protected and preserved.

Mr. Saleem further stated that as the democracy in the Maldives is still very much in its infancy, it is important for the political parties, as well as individual party members and the general public, to work together to create an environment conducive to democracy. He also said that we must realize that democracy cannot be brought in overnight in a country that has never experienced it before, and that very often we see the differences of opinion being translated to personal animosity. Hence, he stated, that a concerted effort must be made by the major political parties in the country to sustain what has been achieved during the past few years in the Parliament through MPs.

Mr. Saleem also said that, the Maldivian Democratic Party, now in power and the main opposition, the Dhivehi Rayyithunge Party, have a huge responsibility to work together and call for unity during the delicate days ahead. Speaking in this respect, Saleem said that short-term political battles must now take a backseat in the interests of promoting the long-term stability of the newly-established constitutional state.

The delegation from HRCM which attended the 14th annual meeting includes HRCM president Mr. Ahmed Saleem, Member Mr. Ahmed Abdul Kareem and Secretary General Mr. Ahmed Naseer Yousuf.

APF Executive Director Delivers lecture for MPs



The Human Rights Commission of the Maldives in collaboration with the Asia Pacific Forum for National Human Rights Institutions (APF) and the People's Majlis conducted a lecture for the members of the Parliament on the Role of Parliamentarians in Protecting and Promoting Human Rights on 17 August 2009.

The lecture held at the Islamic Centre was delivered by the Executive Director of APF, Mr. Kieren Fitzpatrick.

In Mr. Kieren Fitzpatrick's lecture, he spoke about human rights and legislation, the role of the Majlis in holding the executive

accountable, and the importance of representation of the people in the Parliament through MPs.

He spoke extensively on the importance forming a specialist human rights committee with the Majlis in order to best achieve executive accountability for the implementation of the human rights obligations.

Mr. Fitzpatrick advised that the HRCM annual reports and specialist reports and their associated recommendations be debated in the parliament.
