Comments by HRCM on National Migration Health Policy and it's Action Plan and Monitoring and Evaluation Framework for 2022-2025

General Comment(s):

- 1. To include in the policy, accessibility to health care services, including emergency care and access to continuity of care for undocumented and irregular migrants, as one-third of the residential population of Maldives are migrants, and among them at least 60,000 people are identified as undocumented according to 2020 UNDP report.
- 2. To state the Ministry of Health as the responsible authority who will bear the financial costs taken by the hospitals during health care services provided for irregular and undocumented migrants, as these group of people are not enrolled in any health insurance plan and has no employers responsible for them.
- 3. To state once the hospital identifies an undocumented or irregular migrant seeking health care service to allow them to access the health care services or continuity of care.
- 4. To state a procedure that would be followed under this policy if an undocumented or irregular migrant passes away or meets an accident and is in a critical condition.
- 5. To include vulnerable groups such as migrant children, migrant older persons, and persons with disabilities (These are vulnerable groups mentioned in 'Global Action Plan 2019-2023, for promoting the health of refugees and migrants' drafted in 72nd World Health Assembly by WHO) in addition to vulnerable groups such as migrant detainees and migrant women.
- 6. To establish a mechanism to complete mandatory vaccinations for migrant women's newborns.
- 7. To detail the financial and budget allocations needed to implement and achieve the key activities mentioned in the policy by developing results and resource framework.
- 8. Establish a mechanism where the migrants can obtain an affordable health insurance package and establish a mechanism for taking action against employers who neglect or refrains an employee from providing employer-funded health insurance.







- 9. To establish a mechanism to take action against the person or an institution if any of a migrant's health rights are infringed or violated by any concerned authority under the policy.
- 10. To replace "Ministry of Interior" from places stated in the action plan with the relevant Ministry's name.
- 11. Human Rights Commission is an independent body with a separate mandate and acts as a monitoring body of the primary institutions. Therefore, we propose to remove Commission as a primary implementing agency to implement this policy. However, Commission will give input and share comments with the relevant stakeholders when needed.

Key Activities:

•Conduct regular monitoring visits in detention centers for health check-ups and conditions of detention centers and provide medication support to migrants in detention centers or in custody

To amend as recommended below and to add the following in point:

- Conduct regular monitoring visits in detention centers for health check-ups and conditions of detention centers and provide medical support to migrants in all the detention centers under the State.
- To collect available data from monitoring bodies regarding their inspection visits to custodial and detention centers.

It is important to cover all the detention centers under the State.

Collected data from monitoring bodies can be used for later reference.

Cases from both locals and expatriates are investigated. The Human Rights Commission of the Maldives administers a daily hotline for any human right grievance. These complaints can also be filed by submitting form a to Commission. In 2017, out of a total of 365 cases filed at HRCM. 9 cases were filed by foreigners (HRCM, 2017).

Investigates allegations of the violation of human rights, raise awareness on human rights. advise in drafting human rights laws and regulations, advise the Government on the formulation of necessary laws, regulations administrative reviews existing laws and regulations, conduct inspection visits to custodial, detention and rehabilitation centers, monitor human rights situation Maldives. In addition, Commission is to advise the Government and make recommendations as necessary and conduct research and carry out relevant surveys on human rights. Cases from both locals and expatriates are investigated. The Human Rights Commission of the Maldives administers a daily hotline for any human right grievance. These complaints can also be filed by submitting a form to the Commission. In 2021, out of a total of 520 cases filed at HRCM, 37 cases were filed by foreigners (HRCM,2021).

We propose to remove The Human Rights Commission 4.5. Conduct regular monitoring under the title 'Responsible Ministries and Agencies' as visits in detention centers for the Commission is an independent monitoring body and health check-ups and conditions of has an independent mandate to randomly detention centers and provide unannounced visits to detention centers. It is not in medication support to migrants in Commission's mandate to primarily provide health checkups and provide medication support to detainees.

> However, during Commission's inspection visits it and monitors if the implementing primary institutions of the related detention centers provides medical services under their mandate. After these visits Commission will share its reports and recommendations with the responsible authorities and these authorities can also obtain information from the Commission when needed.

Therefore, Commission is proposing to be removed under the title 'Responsible Ministries and Agencies'.

As Human Rights Commission is an independent systematic monitoring body, Commission already advocates the raising activities mentioned in 4.8 under Commission's mandate.
